

SCASC 5 YEAR PLAN

YEAR 1

- Develop a constitution.
- Establish a set of basic election procedures or appointment rules
- Attend a SCASC District Rally

- Send 1-2 students to leadership camp during July.

YEAR 4

- Attend SCASC District Rally
- Attend State Convention and submit projects
- Attend Southern Convention
- Complete application for National Association of Student Councils, National Council of Excellence.

YEAR 5

- Make edits or amendments based on your constitution (no more than 5)
- Have students attend camp, present to the council what they learned

- Attend SCASC District Rally
- Attend State Convention and submit projects
- Attend Southern Convention and Submit projects
- Attend a National Convention
- Consider attending NAWD (National Association of Workshop Directors), in December to gain skills necessary to perfect your skills as an advisor.
- Complete a continuation application for National Council of Excellence, this will be a continuation of year 4, not a completely new application.
